Dear Representatives Spanberger, Gonzalez, Axne and Miller-Meeks:

I am writing to offer [Vizient's](#) support for the Provider Relief Fund Improvement Act (H.R. 5963). The Provider Relief Fund (PRF) has provided a critical lifeline for hospitals and other providers throughout the course of the COVID-19 pandemic.
