

Vaccine concerns among health care workers

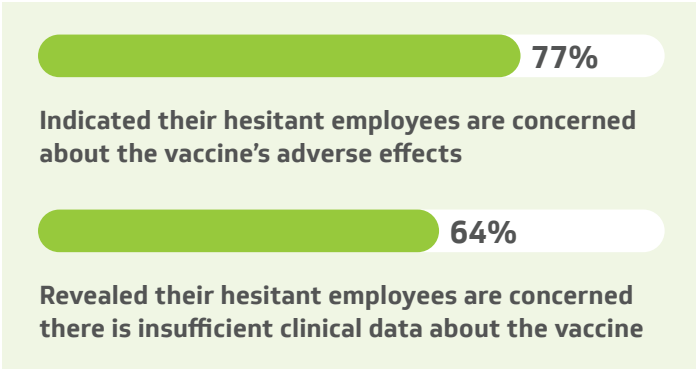
How Vizient members are handling COVID-19 vaccination hesitancy among staff

Methodology: Vizient® Pharmacy Program participants were surveyed about COVID-19 vaccine hesitancy and other early phase vaccination issues, with data collected from Jan. 13-31, 2021. A total of 104 respondents completed the survey in its entirety, with an additional 63 respondents answering at least one survey question.

Vaccine hesitancy

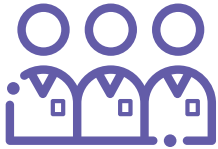
 Members are experiencing significant vaccine hesitancy among their employees

27% Have seen moderate to high vaccine hesitancy



Vaccine administration

Members' vaccination rate for their health care workers is relatively slow



22% Indicated they will have inoculated more than three-fourths of their staff by Jan. 31, 2021



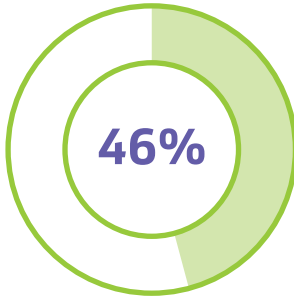
68% Have been prioritizing employee vaccinations based on the risk potential to COVID-19 patients

Extra vaccine product

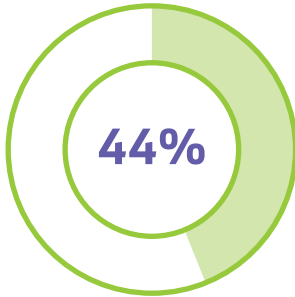
Members plan to offer extra vaccine product on hand to several groups
