The Pharmacy Aggregation Groups program has developed a multigroup strategy by aggregating two or more groups that use high volume and commitment for enhanced pricing. Historically, 50% of the savings members realize from the Pharmacy Aggregation Groups program result from multi-group contracts.

One example of a successful multi-group initiative is the diversification of the biosimilar portfolio to enhance profit margins with preferred agents. In 2023, conversions to new biosimilars yielded an estimated \$190M in additional member value, including increased revenue.


